Registration Due Date: Received on-line by 1:00 p.m. January 11, 2011

1. Online Registration will be available on the QA website starting November 15th. Due to the number of entries that are typically submitted, we require that all entries be submitted on-line, and submitted as early as possible. If you are unable to register on-line, contact Becca Knox. If you have a computer with internet access and need assistance completing the form, contact Julie Robbins or BeccaKnox.
2. Please refer to the Quilt Show 2012 Policies section in the current QA roster to determine if your quilt meets all the eligibility requirements to be entered into the quilt show. The policies are also published on our website.
3. Register online by 1 pm on Wednesday, January 11, 2012. Assistance with entries will be available at both meetings in December and January. Late entries will not be accepted.
4. Complete a separate registration for each item you are entering.
5. The Quilt Show Committee will print story sheets to display with your quilt using the registration information. If you have a longer story or other information you would like to have hung with your quilt in addition to this story sheet, drop it off with your quilt. Do not submit it with your registration. Please be sure all extra information for display is legible and ready to hang.
6. QA is not responsible for any loss of or damage to items entered in the quilt show.
7. **Observe the Entry Limits:** each member is allowed to enter 3 quilts in the voting categories, and:
 - Each member may have one additional entry each in the Miniature and the Wearable categories that does not count against the 3 quilt limit.
 - Showcase entries do count against the 3 quilt limit despite being a non-voting category.
 - Each member may enter one item in the Membership Challenge, which does not count against the limit.
 - Entries in the “by invitation only” categories (Previous Winners and Other Special Display) do not count against the 3 quilt limit.
8. In the event that registrations exceed the capacity of the show members may be asked to withdraw entries.
9. **Observe Hanging Sleeve Guidelines:** Quilts delivered to the show without sleeves cannot be hung.
 - All quilts must have a hanging sleeve. The sleeve should span the width of the quilt and measure 4 inches finished for most entries, 2 inches finished for Miniatures. Exceptions are made for wearables and 3-D objects- no sleeves required.
 - Sleeve instructions are on the website and will be available as hand-outs at the monthly meetings.
 - Hanging sleeves on all quilts must be attached with the top of the sleeve no higher than 90” from the bottom hem of the quilt (must hang no longer than 90 inches) unless it is entered in either of the “Large Quilt - Solo” or “Large Quilt – Duet/Group” categories. Large category quilt sleeves can be at the top of the quilt.
10. QA reserves the right to refuse to hang a quilt if it will cause any access restrictions or be a safety hazard, or if it has special requirements we can't accommodate. Glass-framed objects will not be accepted.
11. **Verify your registrations on-line:** The list of registered items will be available on the website beginning January 16th and ending January 20th. It is the members' responsibility to ensure that registration was completed successfully for each item entered. If you had assistance in registering your quilt on-line, please use that person's e-mail address for your entry so that you can get help in verifying your entry. 12. **Notify us of changes:** If you have entered a quilt and subsequently find that it will not be available for hanging, please contact Becca Knox as soon as possible. Also, if your quilt's width is more than four inches different than what you registered, the layout team needs to know that. Contact Pam Tubbs with that information.
